I have nothing but good things to say about this place. Dr. Kraig Abe and his staff are all absolutely wonderful.

The ladies at the front desk are always kind, welcoming, and very easy to work with. They always give me a call the day before an appointment as a friendly reminder.

As for Dr. Abe - he's caring, knowledgeable, and extremely passionate about his field of work. I came to him as a long time Ortho-K user who had recently developed an astigmatism that left me with no depth perception and vision so poor that I could no longer legally drive at night. In other words, my eyes were so bad that hardly any doctor would even attempt to craft a new set of lenses for me.

Dr. Abe was different. He took the time to sit me down and explain everything to me. He broke down topography maps of my eyes, showed the progression of my astigmatism over recent years, and explained what the lenses would have to do in order to correct my vision.

All in all, it seemed like a long shot and Dr. Abe strongly urged me to go the soft lens route until I could finally get laser eye surgery. However, I was very persistent and he finally conceded. I remember him asking me before I left - "would you be okay with 30/30 vision?" I would have been thrilled with that, but Dr. Abe ended up blowing my expectations away.

After my consultation, he sent me home with several pairs of soft lenses to tide me over until my hard lenses were ready. Unfortunately for me, my lenses were ready long before I was able to get back in for an appointment, so Dr. Abe express mailed a special pair of soft lenses, made for my special astigmatism, straight to my home.

Finally the day came for my Ortho-K fitting and sleep study. I arrived eager and early, ready to try on my new lenses. Dr. Abe got me in early, and explained to me what the goal of the sleep study is and how to attain the best results.

I was finally ready. I put in my lenses, found a comfy chair to lounge in, and got my sleep on. Dr. Abe noticed that I didn't have headphones to keep me entertained, so he even gave me his own personal earbuds to use.

After an hour or so, Dr. Abe woke me up, had me remove my lenses, and brought me into his office to see how the lenses were taking to my eyes.

We were both a little surprised by the results. The lenses had taken to my eyes perfectly. I was seeing 20/20 in both eyes after only an hour of wear. To put this in perspective - I was struggling to make out letters in the 20/60 row just an hour prior. I was ecstatic.

Dr. Abe gave me three goodie bags to get me started with caring for my new lenses. This included a pH rub to break down mineral buildups, saline and plungers to help with removal of lenses, Ortho-K artificial tears for insertion, clear care for general cleaning, etc. I could go on

and on.

Fast forward two months and, apart from having to order new artificial tears, I'm still using the supplies Dr. Abe gave me. I haven't had a single problem with my lenses thus far, and every morning I wake up with 20/20 that lasts until bedtime.
